The main results of food security survey in Kurdistan Region and Iraq for 2016

KRSO publishes the results of Food Security Survey for 2016. The field work of the survey was conducted in May 2016 in cooperation with WFP. The aim is to provide update data on Food security condition of local community and IDPs in accordance with definition confirmed by international congress on food in 1996.

"Food security exists when all people, at all times, have physical, social and economic access to sufficient, safe and nutritious food which meets their dietary needs and food preferences for an active and healthy life."

This survey follows CARI definition to show food security that covers two areas as mentioned below.

This survey identifies three indicators as described below:

Food secure: who have entire access to food and non-food materials without conflicts.

<u>Vulnerable to Food Insecurity:</u> who have less access to food and at the same time do not have access to some non-food material entirely.

<u>Food insecure:</u> who are unable to use food and losing livelihood resources in term of working and asset.










