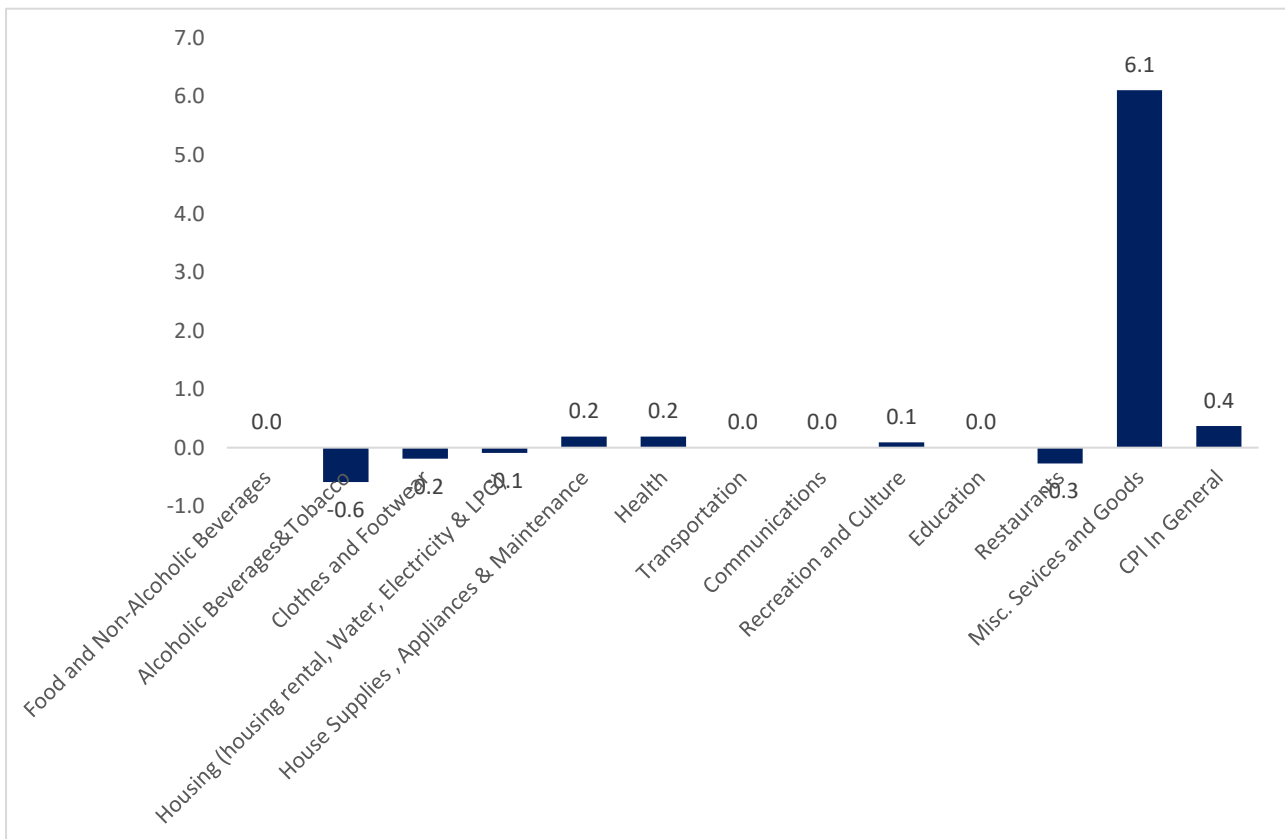

1-Monthly inflation rate

Consumer price index(CPI)reached (108.1) in Kurdistan Region for Sept 2025 showing an increase by 0.4% compared to the previous month due to price increase in the following sections:

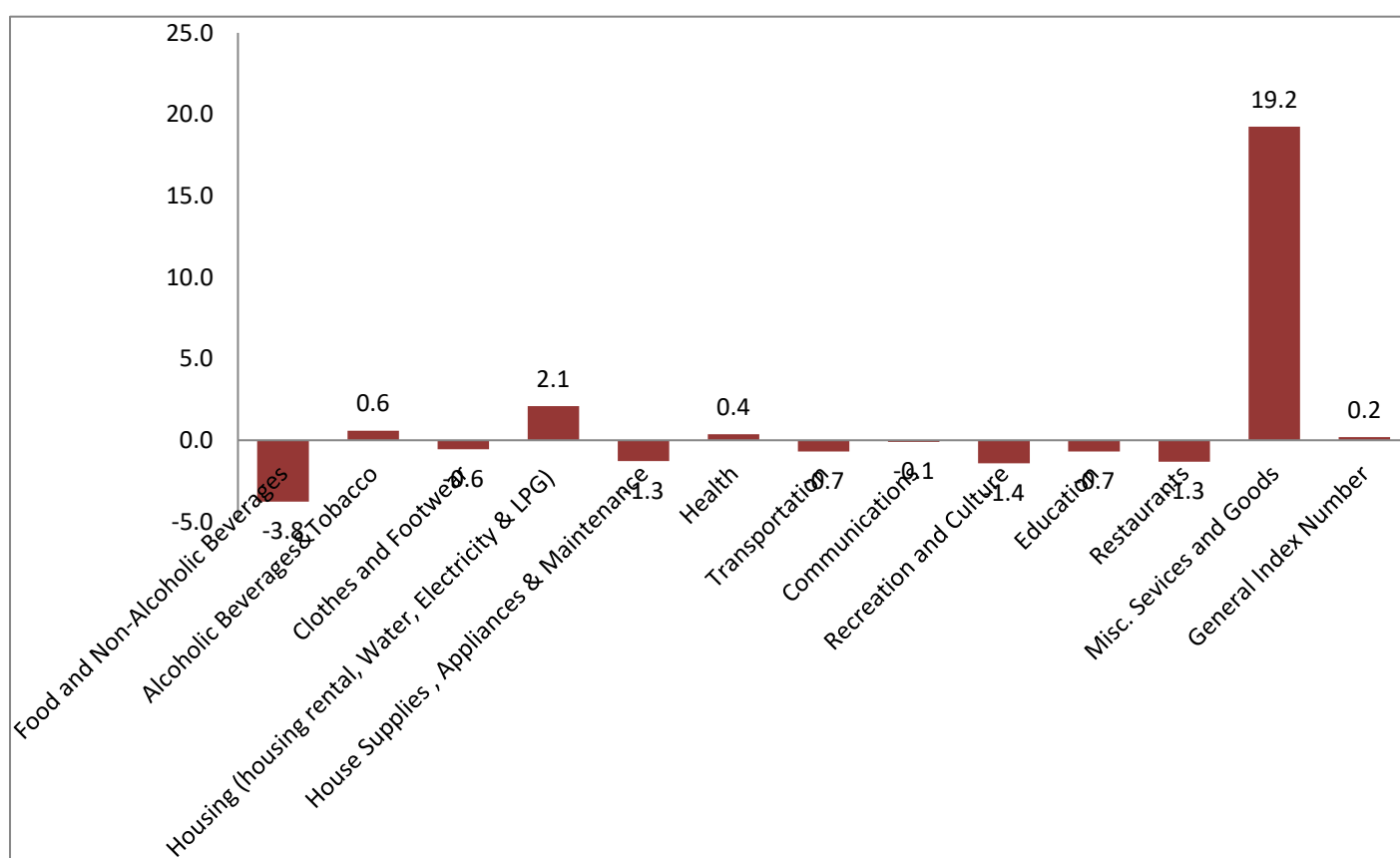
1. Misc. services and goods by 6.1 %,
2. Health & House Supplies, Appliances & Maintenance by 0.2 %,
3. Recreation and Culture by 0.1%,



2-Annual inflation rate

Consumer price index (CPI) in Kurdistan Region reached 108.1 for Sept 2025, where it shows an increase by 0.2% compared to Sept 2024 (107.9) due to increase in the prices of the following sections:

1. Misc. services and goods by 19.2 %,
2. Housing (housing rental, water, electricity & LPG) by 2.1%,
3. Alcoholic Beverages & Tobacco by 0.6%,
4. Health by 0.4 %,



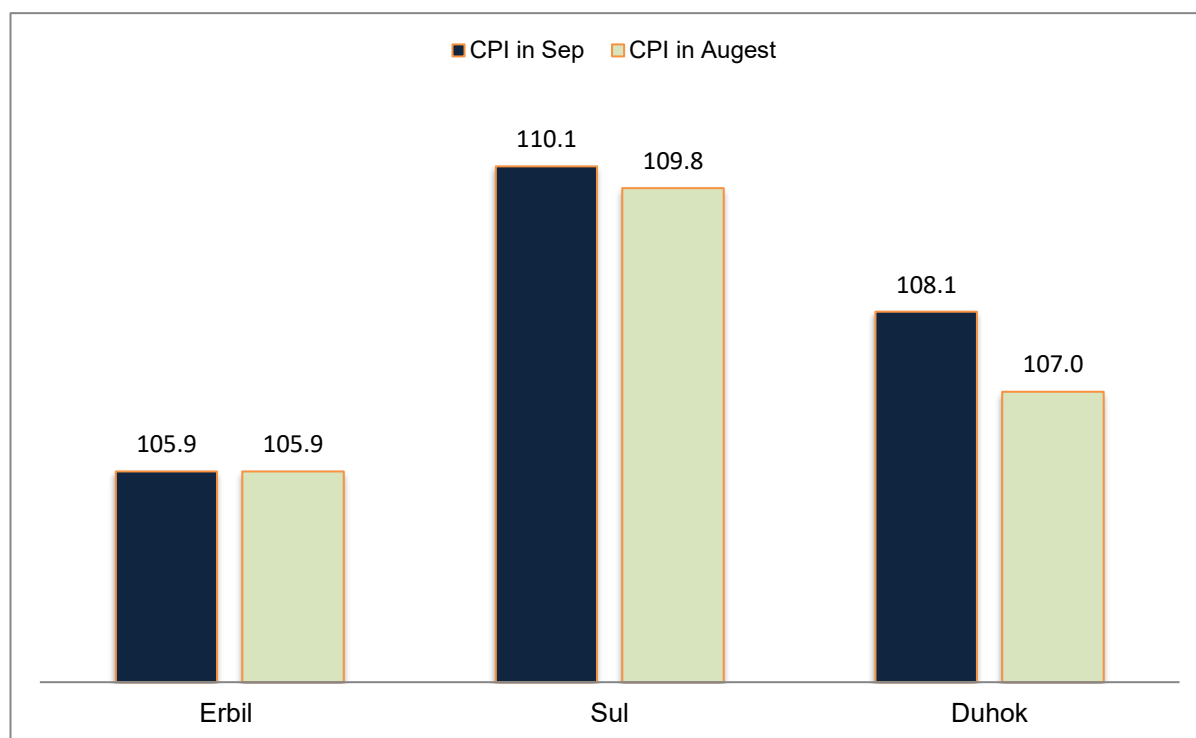
3-Inflation rate compared to 2022 (2022=100%)
